# B. <u>BYLAWS</u>

# 1. **4360 GORDON HEAD ROAD – REZONING TO RS-12.**

Final Reading of the "Zoning Bylaw, 2003, Amendment Bylaw, 2014, No. 9302" **and approval of exemption from the minimum 10% perimeter road frontage requirement for proposed Lot B**. Rezoning from RS-16 to RS-12 for proposed two lot residential subdivision.
