
Sir:

I beg to inform you that the Provincial Board of Health has proclaimed regulations empowering all municipalities in British Columbia to close all schools, churches, theatres and other public meeting places to prevent the spread of Spanish influenza in this Province. Please confer with your Health Department and advise us at once as to the conditions in your Municipality and as to the necessity of putting these regulations into effect there.
