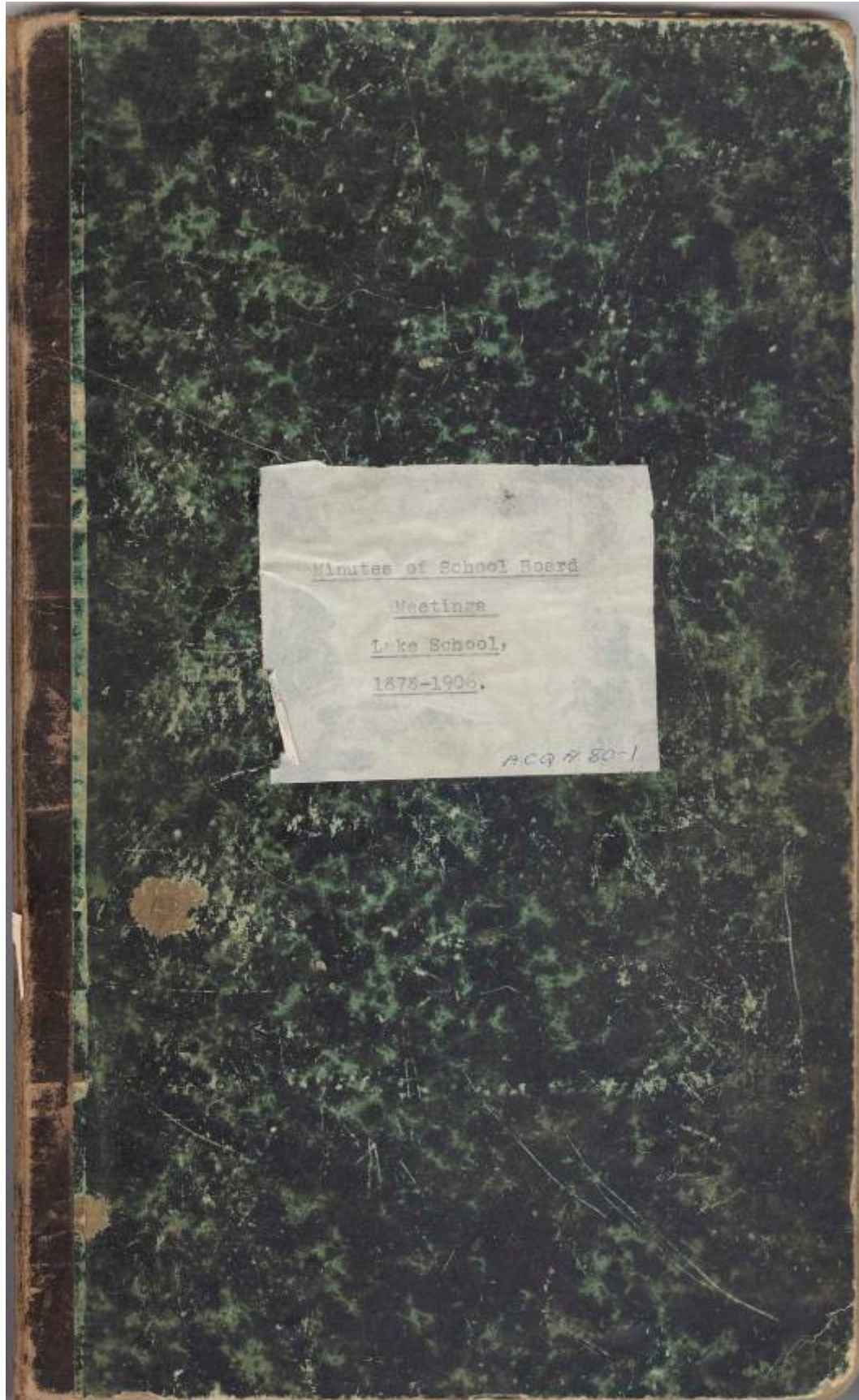

Sir

I beg leave most respectfully on behalf of the Trustees and people of Lake District. to request you to apply to the Governor in Council for a grant of \$400 this being as near as we can estimate to be used for the purpose of erecting a Teachers residence in connection with our school. of which we stand in the greatest need as there is no place for the Teacher to board except in a tavern which is very objectionable to say the least. The present Teacher has to live in a dilapidated old shanty which is not fit for habitation and board himself as best he can herewith you will see a rough ground plan of a little building such as may answer the purpose. The dimensions are as follows 16 x 22 ft 10 ft high with a small kitchen at the back and one fire place in the dining room.

Hoping to receive a favorable reply to this application at your earliest convenience.

I am directed
by the Trustees to inform you
of the results of yesterday's meeting

after giving due consideration to all matters brought before us we have come to the conclusion that David was wrong in using impertinent language either in school or on the road the example is bad and must be stopped and the Trustees all agree that the Master was right in making the boy apologise for his conduct a good example must be set not only for David's sake but for other children which might be inclined to follow in the same way. in our opinion there was no grounds for a charge against the teacher as he admitted the mistake and gave the boy full marks. but it seems from information received that this trouble does not rise from any thing that occurred in school but from ill feeling between your self and the Master and there is no doubt on our minds that the boy was prompted to rise a quarrel with the Master. we received a letter from Mr Lewis complaining very hard of your conduct towards the Trustees he wishes a full investigation of the matter as it affects the school and himself. if you wish to see the letter you can do so by applying to the Trustees. I hope you will take this in a good feeling as the only object of the Trustees is to work in harmony with the people for the good of the school. I have the honor to be very
