Round #1 Natural Areas

- More trees
- Natural areas in Golf course shared access
- Bowker Creek meandering & wetland
- Restoration of Kings Pond
- Add Jenkins Pond to the Park
- Nature Playground
- Improve rain gardens in the Recreation Centre Parking Lots
- Ensure Habitat areas (in and out of the Golf course) are connected to each other – not isolated patches as they are currently

- Daylight the creek where it is in pipes passing through the Golf Course
- Move the chip trail to the edge of the natural areas reducing fragmentation
- Add boardwalk across creek to enhance accessibility and mobility access
- Include children in natural areas restoration

Round #2 Connectivity & Mobility
