#### Supply List:

**\*You do not need to buy supplies before the first class. In the first class we will draw using supplies provided by the Arts Centre.**

The following supplies will be discussed during the first class:

- 3 painting supports:  
One 1 8x10" canvas paper or canvas board, two 1 canvases 11x14" or larger.

#### **Paint:** (water soluble oil or acrylic)

- Ultramarine Blue
- Azo Yellow Middle or Cadmium Middle
- Alizarin Crimson
- Burnt Umber
- Titanium White
- Yellow Ochre \*
- Phthalo Blue\*
- Quinacridone Red\*
- Burnt Sienna\*
- Lemon Yellow\*

*\* denotes colours that are recommended but not required.*

#### **Brushes:**

To be discussed in class. One small, medium and large brush, approximately sizes 2, 6 and 10. It may be nice to have a flat, a round, and a filbert shaped. Palette knife is optional.

#### **Palette:**

To be discussed in class.

**For oils:** a large airtight plastic container with a lid, such as a flat rubbermaid container, or a large piece of stiff cardboard with several layers of wax paper attached.

**For acrylics:** an airtight plastic container as described above, or a "stay wet" palette. These are expensive and not necessary but might be nice to have if you continue on your painting journey!

- **For oils:** Linseed oil, small jar with lid for oil storage.
- Rag for wiping your brush. Oily rags must be spread to dry at home after use.
