This park, located on the Gorge, was once the site of a Kosapsom village and is where the historic Craigflower Schoolhouse is situated.

The park, adjacent to Gorge Waterway Park, features a playground, picnic tables, washrooms, and access to a small beach area. Parking is off Gorge Road W. with pedestrian access off Admirals Rd. where the public art piece 'Bridging Perspectives' is located. Remember to leash your dog when within 10m of the playground.

The Gorge Waterway is part of the Victoria Harbour Migratory Bird Sanctuary (VHMBS). Visitors should be aware that specific rules and regulations apply to this waterway, including some that pertain to dogs.
