Start Your Own Roadside Stand!

Roadside stands are permitted in various urban and rural zones in Saanich. Sell the produce you grow directly to customers from a roadside stand located on your property.

Initiate a Pop-Up Pocket Farm Market!

Sell your agricultural products directly to consumers from a table or vehicle in a parking lot or other outdoor location through a pop-up pocket farm market. Pocket farm markets are permitted in various zones in Saanich.

Establish a Farm Market!

Farm markets are large-scale events that offer local food producers a platform to sell a variety of goods directly to customers. These markets bolster farm businesses, enhance food security, and strengthen communities.

Boulevard gardens add character to neighbourhoods, enhance community pride and support ecological diversity. Food producing plants are permitted to be grown on Saanich boulevards, within certain guidelines.
