# SaanichMap Create a Property Information Report




#### Introduction

The Property Information Report contains useful property details such as lot size and location, zoning, school district, tax levies, and assessments. There are multiple ways to create the report and this guide outlines three options.

### Launch SaanichMap

In any web browser, go to <a href="https://map.saanich.ca">https://map.saanich.ca</a> or go to <a href="www.saanich.ca">www.saanich.ca</a> and choose SaanichMap under the I Want to... menu.


On the GIS page, click on Launch SaanichMap.






## 1. Generate a report for a property you locate on the map

In SaanichMap, zoom in on the map, right click on a property and select **What's here...** from the context menu.


A Report window will appear on the left. Click on **Property Information Report**.

The report will start generating.

Note – this may take a bit of time to run.




Once ready, select Download report file.




This will download a PDF of the Property Report for the selected land parcel. Open it to view the report and share or print.


Click on **Done** to close the report window.



Note – Panels in SaanichMap can be closed by clicking on the 'x' or backing out of them. You can also refresh SaanichMap to reset the window.


#### 2. Generate a report for multiple selected properties

To generate a Property Information Report for multiple properties, navigate to the area of interest. Double click the green Saanich banner to view the menus.




Under Maps & Reports tab, select All Reports.

Under the drop-down menu in the Report window, select **Property Information** and **Submit**.



A prompt asks for properties to be selected.

Use one of three **Selection Tools** to manually draw your selection area.



1. Use **Select by Point** to click on a single parcel at a time. Click on + Add Location to keep adding parcels.

You can choose multiple locations by selecting the +Add Location tool after each selection.



3. Or use **Select by Polygon** to click on the map and drag a polygon shape covering the parcels of interest.



To add more selections, click **Add Location**.

Once selections are complete, click **Submit** to generate a combined report for all properties chosen. Depending on the number of properties selected, this process could take considerable time.




Once the report is generated, click **here** to open it. A new webpage will open with the completed report.

All properties intersecting the search area will be listed in the report one after the other.

### 3. Generate a Property Information Report using Find by Address


A third method to generate a Property Information Report is to use the **Find by Address** tool.

The **Find by Address** tool can be accessed from several places in SaanichMap. When on the homepage of SaanichMap, it can be accessed by clicking the link **Property Information Report**.



Another way to access the tool is from the **I want to...** button at the top left of the window.






From the I Want to... menu click on Property Information report.

A panel will open prompting entry of an address.


Start typing the address of interest and then select the full address from the drop-down list that appears. Click on **Submit** and the site will automatically zoom to the address on the map.



The site will start generating a report for the address that was selected. Once this is complete, a new link will appear on the left panel of the page.



Click on here to open a webpage with the Property information report for the selected address.
