Supply List:

Painting supports:

- One 8 x 10" canvas paper or canvas board, one 11 x 14" or 12 x 16", one large canvas i.e. 18 x 24"

Paint: (water soluble oil or acrylic)

- Ultramarine Blue
- Azo Yellow Middle or Cadmium Middle
- Alizarin Crimson
- Burnt Umber
- Titanium White
- Yellow Ochre *
- Phthalo Blue*
- Quinacridone Red*
- Burnt Sienna*
- Lemon Yellow*

** Denotes colours that are recommended but not required.*

Brushes:

To be discussed in class: A small, medium and large brush, size 2, 6, and 10 approximately. You may want to have to have flat, round, and filbert shaped brushes. Palette knife is optional.

Palette:

For oils: A large airtight plastic container with a lid, (think of a flattish rubbermaid container) or a large piece of stiff cardboard with several layers of wax paper attached. For acrylics: An airtight plastic container as described above, or a stay wet palette. These are expensive and not necessary but might be nice to have if you continue on your painting journey!

Additional Supplies:

- For acrylic paints:
 - Small spray bottle
- For oil paints:
 - Rag for wiping your brush. Oily rags must be spread to dry at home after use.
 - Linseed oil
 - Small jar with lid for oil storage
