Supply List:

Please bring a painting or drawing you are working on and all the supplies you need.

Suggested Basic Supplies:

Please note: Any colour with the word "Hue" in the name is a mixture of pigments that approximate the look of a traditional paint colour. This is used primarily in student quality paint or where traditional pigments are now not used due to toxicity concerns.

Acrylic or water-soluble oil paints in these suggested colours:

- Titanium White (large tube)
- Naphthol Red Medium or Cadmium Red Middle Hue
- Magenta or Alizarin Crimson Hue
- Hansa Yellow Deep or Cadmium Yellow Deep Hue
- Hansa Yellow Light or Cadmium Yellow Light Hue
- Phthalo Blue (Green Shade)
- Ultramarine Blue (Red Shade)
- Burnt Umber
- Yellow Ochre

OR

Watercolour paints in these suggested colours:

- Scarlet Lake or Cadmium Red Medium Hue
- Magenta or Alizarin Crimson Hue
- Indian Yellow or Gamboge Hue
- Windsor Yellow or Lemon Yellow Hue
- Phthalo Blue (Green Shade)
- Ultramarine Blue (Red Shade)

- For acrylics: Acrylic gloss medium
- For oils: Water-soluble painting medium
- Surfaces for acrylics and oils - assorted canvases, canvas boards, boards, canvas sheets or canvas paper.
- Surfaces for watercolours: 140lb. watercolour paper with Gatorfoam board or wood board.
- Drawing paper or sketchbook
- Palette appropriate for type of paint:
 - Acrylics and oils - freezer paper or Mijello Palette with lid recommended.
 - Watercolours - round white plastic palette with large wells for mixing.
- Brushes: Round and flat brushes in various sizes appropriate to type of paint.
- Palette knife (acrylics and oils)
- Plastic containers for water (there are some available in the studio as well).



- Spray bottle (acrylics and watercolours)
- Masking tape
- Painting rags
- Barrier hand cream (optional)
- Apron/painting shirt
- Subject matter for ideas – photos or sketches
